

## Scrap Safety Blueprint

When it comes to developing an effective safety program, knowing where to start is often more difficult than building the program itself. In the Scrap Safety Blueprint process we will lead your management team through an in-depth assessment of your current safety program. Working together, we will identify what you do well, where there are opportunities for improvement and, most importantly, what needs to be done to ensure safety is an integral part of your operation in moving forward. We not only discuss regulatory compliance issues, but we explore cultural elements within your organization that are needed to create a sustainable safety program.

The goal at the end of the session is that we have created a plan that identifies what part of your safety program needs improvement, what you should work on first, and how to obtain the resources to get it done.

A Scrap Safety Blueprint session is typically a seven part process that will take four to eight hours to complete, depending on the complexity of the operation. We will custom tailor the process to fit the size of your company. The key for success is that the leadership team must be actively involved in the discussions. The following is a basic agenda for the session.

### I. Introductions, Overview & Process

Following attendee introductions the ISRI team will cover the Scrap Safety Blueprint 's goal, process, and working agreements.

### II. The Company's Vision & Mission

For us to help you build a better safety program, we need to understand the current structure of the organization, future of the company and how safety plays a role.

### III. Current Safety Program: Strengths and Opportunities

When it comes to safety: What are you good at? What needs work? What exposures keep you awake at night? This is an open discussion with the leadership team. We will act as facilitators to capture key points that will be used later in building the plan.

### IV. Core Element Assessment of Your Safety Program

In most companies, the safety program is made up of a number of parts that are often in different stages of development. Using a scorecard, we will walk you through a process of ranking the core elements of your safety program. From hiring to training, to regulatory compliance and beyond, you will identify what you are doing well and what needs attention. Using a ranking system allows us to focus on what needs the most immediate attention.

### V. Yard Tour

We will tour the facility with the owner(s) of the company. This is not a wall to wall safety

audit, but a chance to better understand the operation and observe the current safety program in action.

#### VI. Building a Safety Blueprint

With the completion of steps 1 through 5 we should have enough data to identify the critical elements needed within the safety program. In this step we will prioritize and construct a plan (blueprint) to strategically implement the elements.

#### VII. Closing

In the closing session, we will discuss the next steps your company should take, how ISRI can support your efforts, and how to access the many safety resources available to you.
